After that he travelled to Puerto Rico and Virgin Islands where he stayed for some time until he moved to Miami (USA). At present he lives in Barcelona.

As composer, he has written more than a hundred works in many different styles, from Classical to Dance music. His admiration for <u>Albéniz</u> inspired him to write successful piano suites, like "Evocación", "Iberiada" and "Fantasía" that have been performed by the best pianists all over the world.
